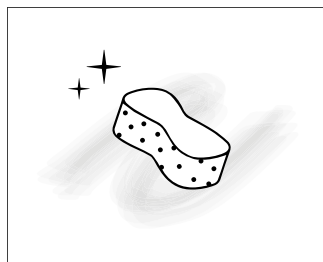


HANGING GUIDE



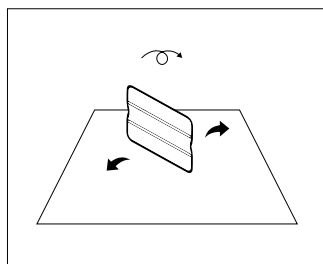
01

Ensure the wall is prepared. The surface needs to be clean, flat, dry, and evenly to assure a perfect adhesion.



02

If you have several decals on one sheet, you can separate them to display them as desired. For large wall decals, position and tape the decal on the wall, before marking all four corners to preview and memorize where the decal will be applied.



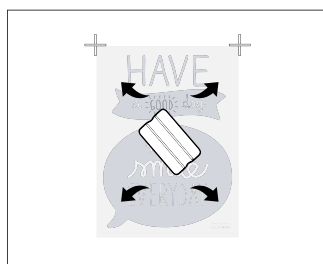

Lay out the flattened wall decal backwards on the floor, and use the squeegee to stick the vinyl to the transfer paper. Insist on small details.

Slowly peel the backing paper away from one side, the vinyl should stick to the transfer paper on top.

Apply the decal on the wall accordingly to your marks, starting by the upper corners. Smooth the wall decal by working from the middle outwards, being careful to remove all air bubbles. Wait a few minutes for the adhesive to stick the decal to the wall.

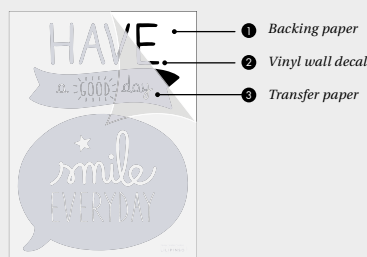
Remove slowly the paper transfer by starting with one corner. Peel the paper away diagonally, at a 45° angle or about. Use a soft and dry cloth and to finalize the application.

YOU WILL NEED



- Masking tape
- Pair of scissors
- Squeegee

PRECAUTION FOR USE

• Surface preparation:

To ensure a perfect application, the area has to be evenly, flat, clean and dry, free of grease and dust. Use a damp cloth to clean and wash gently your wall. Let the wall dry completely (3-4 days) before proceeding.

Freshly painted walls must be left for at least 3 weeks before application.

We don't recommend to apply wall decals on unevenly, rough, porous, sandy or roughcast surfaces. Neither on panelling, wood, fabric, net curtain, wallpaper, paper, tiles, mirror, or plaster.

We can not guarantee an optimal adhesion on these surfaces.

If you have any doubt, do not hesitate to contact us.

• Adhesion:

Repositionable wall decals only upon first application.

Our wall decals are removable easily and do not damage the wall, to the extent that you followed our advices. Take off the wall decal by a corner and peel off slowly.

Lilipinso does not assume responsibility for damages if nothing guarantees that the surface has been perfectly prepared or is of good quality.

Do not apply the wall decal near a radiator or any heat source.

• Colors:

The transfer paper can slightly modify the colors aspect. Colors might be perceived more yellow than they are in reality. It does not affect the product.

An extended exposure to sunlight can cause color fading.

• Resistance and conservation:

Bubbles can appear between the transfer paper and the vinyl graphic decal (due to temperature variations). It does not have any repercussion on the product.

Always store your wall decal in a cool and dry place, in its original packing.

To ensure an optimal grip, apply the decal upon reception.

Keep away wall decals and packagings from children.

TIPS

• To scrape the decal, you can use a squeegee or any flat and smooth object (credit card, ruler...).

• If air bubbles appear, pierce them with a thin needle and softly press them with a finger to take off the air.

• To remove your decal from the wall more easily, you can slightly heat it up with an hairdryer (average heat, 20cm away from the wall decal).

• When it comes to large wall decals, it is better if somebody gives you a hand, it would make it easier to position the wall decal on the wall.
